

Bouncy Castles & Inflatables Do's and Don'ts

DO Clear any animal droppings from the area where you would like the equipment to be set up, before we arrive
This prevents equipment (and people!) becoming soiled and stops the risk of disease being spread



DO Make sure there is a clear path onto the area where you would like the equipment to be set up
This helps our staff to safely and efficiently set up the equipment and minimises the risk of damage to any of your property



DO Remove shoes and any other hard objects such as glasses, keys, phones etc before using the equipment
This prevents dirt getting onto inflatables and reduces the risk of injury

DO Call us if you have any problems at all - Our Contact Details are on the bottom of this form



DON'T Use any of our equipment if you have consumed more than the legal limit of Alcohol
Reduced judgement and lack of co-ordination could cause injuries to self and other people using the equipment

DON'T Take any food or drink onto the equipment
This can be a choking hazard, create slippery surfaces and cause accidents



DON'T Climb on the walls or roof supports
This could cause injury from falling out of the equipment onto hard ground, or falling onto someone else using the equipment below



DON'T Move equipment once it has been set up by our staff, or turn off the power whilst in use
If you move equipment without checking with us first it may mean in the unfortunate event of an accident our insurance will not be valid, plus you could be liable for any damage caused to the equipment. If you are not happy with where the equipment has been set up please use the contact numbers below and we will either send staff out to assist or will provide guidance over the phone. Turning off the power when there are people on the equipment can cause serious injury



IN THE EVENT OF BAD WEATHER

PLEASE NOTE: If the weather forecast on the day of your booking is bad then we will not hire out any equipment for health and safety reasons. However, if bad weather arrives unexpectedly after equipment has been set up here is a guide on the safest practice:



Light Showers During the showers leave the equipment inflated but do not allow anyone to use it. Once the shower has passed, towel dry the surface water before allowing people back on to prevent slips and falls

Heavy, Persistent Rain Leave the equipment inflated to prevent waterlogging but do not allow anyone to use it. Contact us immediately on the numbers below to arrange for us to collect it ASAP

Strong Winds In the event of strong gusts of 15mph plus, ask everyone to come off the equipment and turn off the power as soon as the equipment is empty. Call us on either of the numbers below to arrange for us to collect the equipment ASAP
